TITLE: Organizational Resilience: Securing your organization through ISO 22301 Business Continuity Management System (BCMS)

OBJECTIVE: Traditionally, business continuity were largely focused on IT systems in response to natural disasters and terrorism. In the last twenty years, it has become apparent that organizations shall be prepared for different forms of disruption.

From a government perspective, it is recognized that business continuity can play a vital role in mitigating the effects of disruptive incidents on society. Organizations have to provide the assurance that business continuity arrangements has been thoroughly implemented that there is a good level of consistency in their service provision, despite whatever happens.

Based on similar national standards, ISO 22301 BCMS was developed by the ISO/TC 223, Societal security in 2012. It serves to protect organizations against, reduce the likelihood of occurrence, prepare for, respond to, and recover from disruptive incidents when they arise.
